In addition, a Name verification document (birth certificate or valid current passport) is required for the child.

If copy documents are supplied they must be officially certified by a solicitor, an accountant or an individual authorised by the Financial Services Authority. The certification wording must state that the document is a true copy of the original which has been seen by the certifier and must include the certifier's name, address, position, firm or company. The certifier must also sign and date their certification.

NAME VERIFICATION

- A current valid UK/EU passport
- A UK/EU member state ID card
- A current full UK driving licence (photocard or paper but not a counterpart or a provisional)*
- A blue disabled driver's pass
- H M Revenue and Customs tax notification (less than 12 months old)*
- Pension Service or DWP letter confirming the right to or the receipt of a pension or benefits (less than 12 months old)*
- A current firearms certificate

ADDRESS VERIFICATION

- A local authority tax bill (less than 12 months old)
- A utility bill - not a mobile telephone bill (less than 3 months old)
- A bank, building society or credit card statement (less than 3 months old)
- A mortgage statement from a recognised lender (less than 12 months old)
- A letter from a Government Department relating to the personal affairs of the introducing applicant (less than 12 months old)
- A local authority, housing association tenancy agreement (less than 12 months old)
- A solicitors letter relating to house or land purchase/registration confirming current and previous addresses (less than 6 months old)

* Documents marked with an asterisk can be used for either name or address verification but not both.

Please note all Members must be UK residents.
